Careers Across the Curriculum

1. Aims and Objectives

Aim: To set up a sustainable and transferable framework for bringing schools and businesses together to develop lesson plans to improve the quality of Gatsby Benchmark 4.

Objective 1: To embed careers firmly into the curriculum to ensure that young people can make sense of their subject content and understand how it supports their career aspirations.

Objective 2: To connect teachers with the world of world, offering CPD to build a creative, careers led curriculum.

Objective 3: To raise employer profiles, including those in local growth sectors, and build talent pipelines to support economic recovery.

Measuring Impact: Baselining dependent on learning outcomes for delivery

- 1) School Improvement
- 2) Lesson plan modelling
- 3) Bridging curriculum / world of work gaps
- 4) Impact on local economy

2. The Framework



The lesson plan development is completed over three meetings with additional work and actions being completed between:

- 1. The Employer Meeting
- 2. Employer/ Curriculum Staff Meeting
- 3. Review Meeting

Schools/colleges are involved from step 2.

3. Delivery

Employer Meeting

Agenda for the meeting:

- i. Purpose
- ii. Aims and objectives
- iii. Delivery expectations
- iv. Overview of the business
- v. Identification of subject to approach

Employer/Curriculum Staff Meeting

Agenda for the meeting:

- i. Introductions
- ii. Review of aims, objectives and expectations (with timeline and example of what wanting to achieve)
- iii. Employer to share overview of their role
- iv. EC to facilitate discussion of possible links including ideas around resources with teacher and employer
- v. Agree next steps

Development of Lesson

- 1. Teacher to write or amend an existing lesson following on from discussion with employer, adding "wish list" items needed to bring the lesson to life
- 2. "Wish list" items to be highlighted in the lesson
- 3. Lesson is then shared with the employer to add discussed items
- 4. Teacher to test the initial lesson with students

Review Meeting

Agenda for the meeting:

- i. Run through of the lesson
- ii. Discuss any amendments required
- iii. Lesson to be branded by the employer

Test and Share

- 1. Teacher to launch lesson plan across the school, when appropriate
- 2. Lesson plan to be shared via the Liverpool City Region Careers Hub's website
