BM2 - Learning from Labour Market Information (LMI)

What is LMI?

LMI effectively describes the world of work – ranging from descriptions of different careers, their entry routes, salaries paid, skills and qualifications needed, etc.

LMI also covers future demand – what kinds of jobs will be in demand after leaving school and what kinds of skills will be needed.

For effective career decision making, students will need access to high quality, up-to-date LMI so that information about opportunities available now and in the future can be considered.

Teachers can support the development of career decision making skills by providing accurate and reliable LMI that enables them to weigh-up their potential options at key decision points.
