Liverpool City Region Careers Hub Benchmark 1: Presenting your Careers Programme to Key Stakeholders







It is essential for key stakeholders to know what you are working towards and how you are going to get there. However, they do not all need the level of detail shown in your careers programme.

Key Stakeholders to Consider:

- Students
- Parents
- Staff
- SLT
- Governors
- Employers
- Ofsted

These stakeholders need <u>different</u> information and insight into your programme. Consider what each group of stakeholders may need to know about the following:

1. The Intent of your Programme

- Vision, strategic objectives and learning outcomes
- Statutory Expectations, Careers Strategy Guidance

2. Delivery/Activity

- Benchmark progress use **Compass+** to show how this has altered over time
- How careers is embedded in the curriculum
- An overview of careers activities to highlight progressive learning
- Data on the progress of specific cohorts
- Students level data how your programme supports each student
- Key partnership links e.g., support from LCR Careers Hub
- Employer links

3. Impact

- Destinations data
- · Evaluation processes and findings
- Stakeholder voice
- Success stories
- Student progress against LOs

Careers Website

Your website acts as a 'shop window' for the careers provision that your school offers. This will be accessed by multiple stakeholders and will have to meet their needs and fulfil statutory requirements.
