For lots of companies, ours included, there is plenty of desire and ambition to volunteer with young people, but the organisational side of things can be challenging and use up already stretched time and resources. Having you and the team take care of all of the set up, logistics, introductions, GDPR, etc etc goes such a long way in enabling us to have the best impact possible, sharing our experiences in the world of work and hopefully inspiring some young people along the way. It also makes it an easier sell to our managers (and get the time approved) as we have a bigger impact with a smaller time investment.

At Ramboll we see such a need for these kind of events in increasing 1) the diversity of people employed in our sector and 2) increasing the diversity of employment options in LCR, and the scale and ease your facilitation provides is exceptional. As I mentioned I'm quite involved with developing our social value strategy at a corporate level, as well as how we measure our impact (where my economics background comes in) and partnering with All About Futures to maximise our reach is a no brainer.
